

## NOTE TO USERS

# Deployment Policy for Vision Software

## Development Licenses

---

Pursuant to National Instruments Software License Agreement, the following Vision development software is licensed to run on only one development machine:

- Vision Development Module—Development
- Vision Builder for Automated Inspection—Full-Featured
- Vision Acquisition Software (includes NI-IMAQdx)

## Debug Licenses

---

Pursuant to National Instruments Software License Agreement, the following Vision debug licenses may only be used for debugging programs on one target machine, and cannot be used to develop new programs:

- Vision Development Module—Debug Deployment

## Deployment License

---

Deploying executables or applications that contain Vision software functions requires the corresponding Vision software to be installed for deployment on each target machine.

The following Vision Deployment licenses are included with all supported hardware targets manufactured by National Instruments, regardless of the operating system of the target machine:

- Vision Development Module—Runtime
- Vision Builder for Automated Inspection—Runtime
- Vision Acquisition Software (includes NI-IMAQdx)

If the operating system for that target requires NI License Manager to activate deployment licenses (e.g. Windows-based target machines), contact National Instruments for more information.

If you deploy applications to hardware targets not manufactured by National Instruments, Vision software must be licensed for each target, regardless of the operating system of the target machine. Once purchased, Vision deployment licenses are valid for all versions of the software, including future releases.
