

NOTE TO USERS

PCI-4461 Installation

Most new Dell PCs substitute a tabbed securing lever for a captive screw for use in holding a PCI device in its slot. The design of the PCI-4461 might impede this securing lever from snapping into place. Do *not* force the securing lever to snap. Doing so might cause physical damage to the board and/or the PC.

To make good ground connection with the PC chassis to ensure best noise performance and ESD protection, secure the PCI-4461 in place with an appropriate metallic screw.
