Common Objections

- *Objection 1: "The conference is too expensive."*
 - Response: NIWeek 2020 can give us ideas on how to accelerate projects because it provides sessions on developer techniques, industry strategies and trends, and workflow and production process improvements. It offers a holistic view of the issues impacting engineering.
